 - We will need 8-10 chaperones (3 school buses)
- Wind Ensemble is attending 3 state qualifying events (festivals)
 - 1) OSU Band Festival, either Monday, Feb 27
 - a. MAX 5 chaperones because we have to take a charter bus
 - 2) George Fox Band Festival on Thursday, March 9 (listed above)
 - 3) Metro Band Festival, April 13 at Glencoe HS – need about 5 chaperones
