- All students who wish to receive a letter award **must** do the following:
- Be a member of the band program all year.
 - Have no unexcused absences from any concert or performance with any band.
 - Complete a letter award application (this form) with supporting documentation.

In addition, students must earn **150** points or more as follows:

Be a Section Leader for the Marching Band.	15	
Be a Drum Major.	20	
Be a member of the Jazz Band.	25/sem. 50/year	
As a member of the Wind Ensemble, perform on a secondary instrument in Symphonic Band.	10/sem. 25/year	
Perform with the Pep Band at 8 or more out of 10 <u>regular season</u> basketball games.	30	
After 8 Pep Band Games in the regular season, each additional game is 5 points each (multiply additional games by 5)	20 max	
Perform in the pit orchestra for the spring musical (must be an auditioned member)	30	
Participate in PYP/MYS/PYJO/OPAYCO for an entire season. Provide documentation.	40	
Perform on an instrument in a garage band, church ensemble, or other organized, non-Westview affiliated group (excluding honor bands). Provide documentation.	20 each 40 max	
Participate in Winter Percussion for an entire season with no unexcused absences.	50	
Take private lessons on your primary instrument – on a regular basis – for at least 6 months. Provide documentation.	50
